

# ***CDC 101: Bargue Plates and Casts:***

**Introduction to materials and fundamentals of drawing from plates and casts.**

***Course Description:*** This class is designed to introduce students to the materials associated with charcoal drawing, as well as to teach them a working method to produce sound drawings. This entails the concepts of shape, value, and edge, as well as tools for measuring, such as sight size, triangulation, and comparative measurement. In the first half of the course students work from the historic Bargue Plates, creating the same drawings executed in European schools of the 1800's. In the second half of the course students copy plaster casts, utilizing what they have learned to translate a 3-dimensional object into a 2-dimensional drawing.
